

Dear Parents:

It is that time of the year for the annual Block Kids Building Competition being sponsored by Chapter 87 of the National Association of Women in Construction (NAWIC).

WHAT IS BLOCK KIDS? Give a child a piece of string, a piece of foil, a piece of poster board and 75-100 blocks and their ideas and what do you have? THAT IS BLOCK KIDS.

It will be held on November 4, 2023 at Cole-Clark Boys & Girls Club, Hobe Sound. The competition is for all children in grades Kindergarten through 6th Grade in the Palm Beach County and the Treasure Coast.

All materials are furnished by NAWIC for the competition. The children have up to one hour to build something (no people or animals) and then they are asked questions and judged on their project. There will be 3 groups: K-2, 3 & 4, and 5 & 6, with a prize for the winner of each group. Each child is given a swag bag and a certificate.

Each child is asked to bring 2 cans of food which will be donated to the needy.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS/CONTEST RULES

ELIGIBILITY

This contest is open to ALL children, currently enrolled in grades Kindergarten (K) through six (6), except PREVIOUS NATIONAL WINNERS. Entry in contest must be through a RECOGNIZED SPONSOR.

RULES

- 1. All building projects must be completed where and when designated by Sponsor.
- 2. All building projects must be completed within the allotted time.
- 3. All building projects must be completed using approved materials only.
- 4. All building projects must be relevant to the construction industry. Projects which depict people or animals will not be allowed.
- 5. All building projects must be completed by entrant, with no outside assistance from parents, teachers, etc.
- 6. Every participant must submit the Official Registration/Entry Form, signed by a parent or Guardian.

PRIZES

- 1. Each of these eight Region semi-finalists winning Region entries will be submitted for consideration in the National finals, along with entries from non-NAWIC Sponsors, to become eligible for National prizes.
- 2. There may be a First Place, Second Place and Third Place National prize award.
- 3. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of local Sponsors.

PRIZE AWARD

- 1. Region semi-finalists may be announced at NAWIC Region Forum.
- 2. National winners will be announced at the NAWIC Annual Conference.
